

## Cnoc nam Faobh (Drum Fada) Oak Wood



Cnoc nam Faobh, the oak wood is between the Drum Fada houses and the sawmill and rises from the main road (A830) up to and around the graveyard. On a rocky knoll, it is a prominent feature of the Corpach landscape. It is an area of about 4 hectares and contains mature oak and a mixture of birch, alder and other species. There is some regeneration of oak but not much. The area includes quite a large proportion of open boggy ground and is crossed by several power lines. Through the oakwood and leading up

to and around the graveyard there is a gravel based footpath. Access from the neighbouring housing estate is easy as there is an unfenced boundary on the main road side and entry points either side of the graveyard. There are also the remains of old stiles leading onto the surrounding farm and hill ground.
